GENERAL INFORMATION

Payment Deadline: Payments must be received by August 20, 2017 to receive full benefits. Unpaid pledges will result in loss of benefits, including exhibit space and listing in printed materials.

Cancellations: In the event of the conference being canceled due to fire, strikes, government regulations, Acts of God or other causes beyond the control of the sponsoring organization, AIANTA or its agents shall not be held liable for failure to hold the Conference.

Tax Deduction: AIANTA is recognized under IRS sec. 501(c)(3) and donations qualify as charitable deductions.

Artisans: AITC offers American Indian artisans and Native-owned businesses the opportunity to sell their handmade and handcrafted works during the conference. AIANTA adheres to the Indian Arts and Crafts Act to define who is an Indian artist. Please be prepared to share your tribal documentation if requested. Payment must be received in order to set-up.

Table Assignments: Space assignments will be made at the discretion of AIANTA. Payment must be received in order for the pledge to be considered accepted. Cancellations will result in a \$50 cancellation fee.

Shipping/Storage: Exhibitors and artisans will receive logistical information on shipping/load-in and out, after the pledge has been confirmed. All exhibitors and artisans are responsible for shipping costs and making arrangements.

Security/Liability: The exhibit and artisan area is not secure. The exhibitor and artisan assumes total responsibility for losses, damages and claims arising out of damage of the exhibitor's displays, equipment and other property brought upon the premises of the host facility. He/she shall indemnify and hold harmless the host facility and its sponsors/organizers or any other authorized representative agent or employee of the foregoing for any and all losses, damages and claims.

Damage: Exhibitors and artisans will not fasten any fixtures to the floors, walls, columns or ceilings of the exhibit area. Exhibitors and artisans will be liable for any damages caused by such fastening and for any damage to equipment furnished by service suppliers designated by them.

Permits/Licenses: Each exhibitor and artisan is responsible for obtaining all necessary licenses and permits to use music, photographs or other copyrighted material. The exhibitor and artisan shall remain liable for and shall indemnify AIANTA, their agents and employees, harmless from all loss, cost claims, causes of actions, suits, damages, liability, expenses and costs, including reasonable attorney's fees, arising from or out of any violations or infringements (or claimed violation or infringement) by exhibitor, exhibitor's agent or employees of any patent, copyright or trade secret rights or privilege.
